Prime Geographic Location

- 90 minutes to St. Andrews, the Bay of Fundy, and Moncton, and 60 minutes to Saint John and to the US border and I-95 at Houlton, ME.
- Closer to Ontario and Quebec than any other major city in Atlantic Canada.

Air Service: The Fredericton International Airport (YFC) (14km / 9 mi. from downtown) offers direct daily service to major hubs: Toronto (Pearson & Billy Bishop), Montreal, Ottawa, and Halifax and is served by Air Canada, WestJet, Porter and PAL Airlines along with seasonal service to sun destinations. A major Airport expansion and renovations were completed in 2021.

- A Entering at Quebec / Edmundston, NB Border: Travel the Trans Canada Highway Route 2 and arrive in Fredericton in 3hrs. Exit 280 or 285A, Scenic Route Exit 258.
- B Entering at Houlton, Maine / Woodstock, NB Border: Travel along the TCH and arrive in Fredericton in 1 hr. Exit 280, 285, Scenic Route Exit 258.
- C Entry from St. Andrews, Maine / NB Border: Travel along Route 3 and arrive in Fredericton in 1 1/2hrs.
- D Entry from Nova Scotia, PEI, Moncton and Saint John on TCH Route 2, Exit 294, 285B, Scenic Route 333.

- The **Historic Garrison District**, a National Historic Site, offers free daily entertainment in summer like the Changing of the Guard Ceremony.
