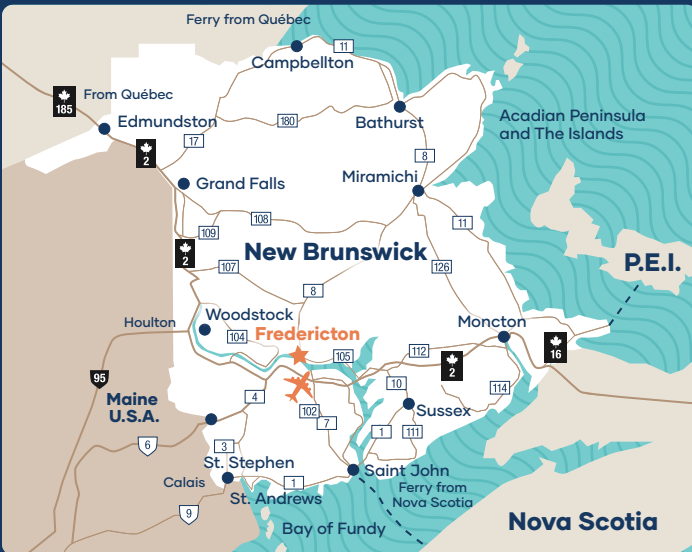

### AIR SERVICE

Fredericton International Airport (YFC) (14km / 9 mi. from downtown) offers direct daily service to major hubs: Toronto (Pearson & Billy Bishop), Montreal, Ottawa and Calgary. Serviced by carriers including Air Canada, Porter and Lynx Air (starting June 2023).

## FANTASTIC URBAN AMENITIES

- At the heart of the region lies the Wolastoq (St. John River) a playground for all to explore.
- Construction starts soon on a new state-of-the-art **Performing Arts Centre**.
- One of the best **trail systems** in the Maritimes! Network of over **120 km/75 mi.** of wide, flat, and wheelchair accessible trails. E-scooter, E-bike, and bike rentals available.
- A quaint downtown with unique boutiques, hand-crafted treasures, plenty of cafes and al fresco dining.
- Explore the Fredericton Capital Region Public Art Trail.

## OUTSTANDING ATTRACTIONS & FESTIVALS

- The **Beaverbrook Art Gallery** is one of Canada's best art museums, famous for its Dalí paintings and impressive collection of Canadian and British art.
- **Kings Landing** is one of Canada's largest living history museums and where over 100 years of New Brunswick's history and culture comes to life. Celebrating its 50 year anniversary in 2024.
- The **Historic Garrison District**, a National Historic Site, offers free daily entertainment all summer – Changing of the Guard Ceremony, outdoor concerts, theatre, "Under the Stars" Classic Film Series and walking tours, all in newly refurbished Officers Square, opening in 2024.
- Some of Canada's best, biggest & oldest festivals; **Harvest Music Festival, NB Highland Games Festival, Summer Chamber Music Festival, Provincial Exhibition** and **Big Axe Craft Beer Festival**.
- Fredericton loves markets! From the festive atmosphere of the **Garrison Night Market**, to the tradition of Saturday mornings at the **Boyce Farmers' Market** and the many farm markets in the region.
- The Capital Region is known for **culture and art**. Find unique hand-crafted treasures in galleries, boutiques and craft shops with working artisans.
- We're a **Craft Brew capital** boasting the largest number of craft brewers per capita in the Maritimes (25+ local breweries, cideries, distilleries, wineries and even a meadery).





## MUST-SEE LANDMARKS

- The **Wolastoq** (Saint John River) is one of the most historic rivers in Canada, with its 10,000 years of Wolastoqiyik or Maliseet history to 400 years of rich stories of French and then English settlement.
- Some of the finest **heritage architecture** in Canada, including the Legislative Assembly, Government House, City Hall and Christ Church Cathedral, one of the finest examples of Gothic architecture in North America.
- The **Big Axe** (49 ft tall) in Nackawic (named Forestry Capital of Canada in 1991).
- The **Big Fiddle**, in Harvey stands 15 ft tall and honors local fiddling hero Don Messer.
- **Bill Thorpe Walking Bridge** – former train bridge, now part of the Trans Canada Trail.
- **Harvey's Big Potato**, the largest in the world, at Silver Valley Farms vegetable stand in Maugerville.

## EXCEPTIONAL TOURISM ROUTES AND TOURS

- With wide open skies, and stunning river valley, one of the most idyllic scenic routes is the **Loop Scenic Drive** in Nackawic.
- **Wabanaki Tree Spirit** offers medicine walks, workshops and culinary experiences.
- The **Fredericton taproom trail** features the regions microbreweries and distilleries.
- Free guided heritage walking tours daily.
- Paddle the heritage Wolastoq (Saint John River) with **Canoe, kayak and paddleboard tours & rentals.**
- **Walking tours** and **step-on guide** service.
- **Haunted Hikes** – meet the ghosts of Fredericton's past on an evening tour.
