# VENDOR CHECKLIST

Use this checklist to ensure you're prepared to participate in the market:

- Confirm your assigned market dates
- Confirm invoice details and rentals (tents, tables, power)
- Secure all required health permits, insurance, and/or licenses
- Complete Vendor Code of Conduct agreement
- Attend the online or in-person orientation session
- Prepare signage (ensure you include signs for pricing, branding, and menu)
- Bring mandatory tent weights – don't forget lights for the evening, and side walls if needed
- Promote your attendance on social media – tag @garrisonnightmarket!

## WEEKLY TIMELINE

-  **MONDAY**  
To receive a full refund, vendors must cancel by 12:00pm  
\*Please note, our team will confirm your cancellation on Tuesday
-  **TUESDAY**  
Vendors will receive an email with this week's placements, updates, and important information. Please be patient – this may not arrive until afternoon
-  **THURSDAY**  
If you need support on site, find a staff member in a green shirt! Our team will not be able to answer emails and/or phone calls during the market
-  **FRIDAY**

# MARKET DAY EXPECTATIONS

## ARRIVAL AND BOOTH SET-UP

---

### 1:30 PM Food Truck set-up begins

Please allow food trucks to set-up first to ease traffic flow on Carleton Street.

### 2:30 PM General vendor set-up begins

Vendors on Carleton Street may bring their vehicles right to their space. Vendors in Officers' Square will need to unload from the Food Alley parking lot.

#### Tent and table pick-up

Rented tents and tables can be picked up from the Baby Barn or Events Centre (see vendor site map). Vendors are responsible for setting up their tents.

#### Power hook up

If you requested power, a member of The 506 Crew will stop by your tent to connect your power. Please be patient while you await your hook up.

### 4:00 PM Carleton Street closes to traffic

All vehicles must be removed from Carleton Street and the Food Alley parking lot. There is NO PARKING anywhere on-site.

### 4:30 PM Garrison Night Market begins!

The moment we are all waiting for! Please ensure your booth is set-up and you are ready to sell before the market begins. Don't forget to have fun!

## VENDOR PARKING

There is no parking for vendors anywhere on-site. Paid parking can be found at:



### East End Parking Garage

635 King St.  
Payment Required 24/7  
\$1.25/hour



### York Street Carpark

North end of York Street, behind City Hall  
Payment required until 5pm  
\$1.25/hour



### The Tannery Lot

300 block of King Street  
Payment required until 5pm  
\$2.00/hour



### Kings Place Parking Garage

\*Privately Owned  
440 King Street (enter garage from Brunswick Street)  
Payment required until 6pm  
\$1.75/hour



### Street Parking

Available throughout the Downtown area  
Payment required until 5pm  
\$1.25/hour



# VENDOR TEAR DOWN

## 9:00 PM Tear down begins

Vendors are not permitted to begin tear down before this time. Make sure to follow all rules and regulations outlined by email and in this document.

### Tent and table rental return

Rented tents and tables must be returned to the location where you picked them up.

## 9:30 PM Carleton Street opens to traffic

At this time, vehicles may re-enter Carleton Street to load your belongings.

## 10:00 PM Vendor tear down ends

All vendors must vacate the premises.

# RULES AND REGULATIONS

## Clean up garbage and waste

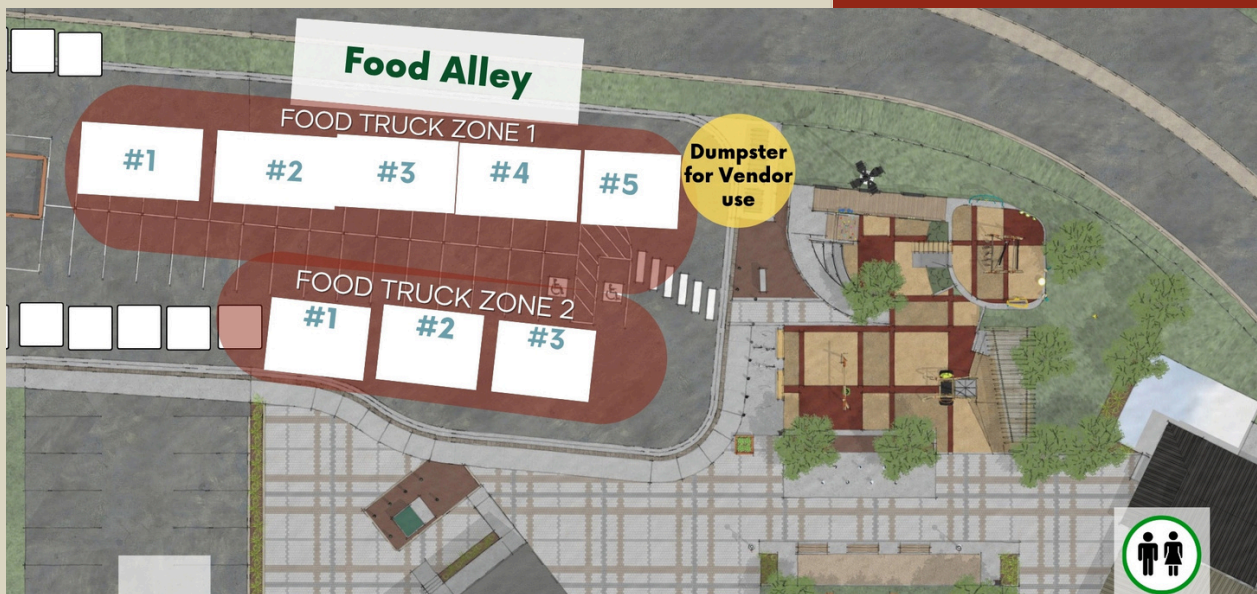
Leave your space how you found it. Garbage must be disposed of in the dumpster in the Food Alley parking lot. NO other dumpsters should be used to dispose of waste.


## Dispose of grey water and grease

Use the designated liquid disposal bucket (located beside the dumpsters). Do NOT dump liquids of any kind down the sewage drain.

## Drive slowly and carefully

Please be mindful of other vendors and patrons.

## TENT WEIGHTS

Prepare for wind and rain! Bring tent weights and side walls. The Garrison Night Market cannot provide these.



## LIGHTING

Battery powered lighting is strongly recommended for visibility in the evening. Power is available only if requested in advance.



## PRESENTATION

Neat and tidy presentation helps draw patrons to your booth and shows customers what you have to offer.



## SIGNAGE

Display your business name, menu, pricing, and payment options. Clear and visible signage helps immensely.
